END POINT ASSESSMENT

Introduction

End point assessments are being introduced to Apprentice programmes from 2016. Lomax Training Services will support and participate the introduction of end point assessments for apprentice programmes.

The end-point assessment concludes the apprenticeship programme. Typically the apprentice will have completed 12 to 18 months' employment and must have passed their external qualifications. They will also have the appropriate level of mathematics and English qualifications, obtained either during or before their apprenticeship.

The nature of the end-point assessments are designed to ensure that the apprentice is able to draw extensively from across the programme, to integrate knowledge, understanding and skills in authentic and demanding workplace contexts, and to apply their skills in a variety of ways which will demonstrate their professional competence.

The end-point assessment is summative, comprehensive and synoptic, involving a showcase portfolio of workplace evidence, a project on a substantive work-based topic, culminating in a formal presentation and interview.
