Course Subjects Covered:

- Safe work practices required when working on the network and highway.
- Demonstrate the safe working practices and procedures for installing and replacing gas mains.
- Identifying common hazards.
- Protecting our environment.
- Safely working in excavations.
- How to join, install and test pipework.
- Positive relationships in the workplace.

Technical Information

Learners will be able to safely install, maintain, test and decommission mains pipework.

Assessment Type: City and Guilds certification within centre assessments, onsite assessment and portfolio build.
