

## Level 2 Plumbing Studies

This course provides trainees with the training required within a realistic working environment to complete a Level 2 in Plumbing qualification. All training completed within centre enables trainees to qualify at an 'Improver/Plumber's mate' level.

Note: Route available to fully qualify as a plumber if on-site evidence is gained. This route will require extra guided learning hours and units to achieve.

Duration:	2 Day's per week for 8 months
