This gas safety assessment is designed to test the gas safety competence of an operative in the work of commission, service, repair & breakdown of gas booster/compressor installations, associated controls & high-pressure pipe work. This certificate needs to be renewed every 5 years.

Completion of this qualification will enable individuals to show competency on the Gas Safe register.
