Who is this for?

- This course is for experienced operatives who wish to undertake commission, service, repair and breakdown of commercial radiant tube heaters and radiant plaque heaters.
- Operatives must hold either the Core Commercial Gas Safety (COCN1) qualification or the Changeover Domestic to Commercial Gas Safety (CODNCO1) qualification and Installation First Fix Commercial Pipework (ICPN) for pipework in excess of 35mm diameter.
- Note: This is normally done as a package with CIGA and CDGA.
