

# Distribution Boot Camp

## Network Construction Operations (Gas) Main Layer

---

This course will provide the learners with the knowledge and understanding of how to safely install and maintain mains pipework on the UK gas network. It will provide the necessary training and assessment to achieve a City & Guilds level 2 certificate in Network Construction Operations (Gas) Main Layer and EUSR registration.

<b>Duration:</b>	11 Days
<b>Course space:</b>	Maximum 8 Learners
<b>Method of delivery:</b>	This course comprises structured theory sessions and trainer led demonstrations. This will be supported by written and practical assessments to demonstrate the learners understanding of the subject matter.
<b>Who is it for?</b>	All operatives that are required to be a potential team leader installing, maintaining, or replacing gas main installations on the UK network. Learners must already hold a valid certificate at NCO Level 1 and a valid SHEA passport. Learners must be working on the UK network on main laying work to gain experience and build a portfolio of evidence.

### Course Objectives

On successful completion the course learners will be able to:

- State the safe systems of work required when working on the network and highway.
- Demonstrate the safe working practices and procedures for installing and replacing gas mains.
- State the procedure for safely working in excavations.
- Demonstrate how to join, install and test pipework.
- Demonstrate how to decommission pipework in line with procedures.
- Demonstrate how to build and maintain positive relationships in the workplace.

### How much does it cost?

These courses are fully funded for independent learners. (Those not taking the course through an employer)

Employers using Bootcamps to upskill their workforce will be required to pay a contribution. (10% for SME and 30% for larger employers)

### Am I eligible?

To be eligible you must be:

- Over 19 or older on 31<sup>st</sup> August within the current academic year
- Live within Gateshead, Sunderland, South Tyneside, Newcastle, North Tyneside, Northumberland, or County Durham.
- Have the right to work in the UK.
