

# Upstream Boot Camp

## Escape, Locate and Repair

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This course will provide the learners with a knowledge and understanding of how to safely deal with external escape on the UK gas network. It will also provide the learner with the knowledge and skills to undertake repairs to the network and to maintain public and site safety.

<b>Duration:</b>	10 Days
<b>Course space:</b>	Maximum 8 Learners
<b>Method of delivery:</b>	This course comprises structured theory sessions and trainer led demonstrations. This will be supported by written and practical assessments to demonstrate the learners understanding of the subject matter.
<b>Who is it for?</b>	All operatives that are required to attend emergencies on the UK gas network. Learners must already hold a valid Mains or Service laying certificate at Level 2. Learners must be working on the UK network on emergency work to gain experience and build a portfolio of evidence.

### Course Objectives

On successful completion the course learners will be able to:

- State the priorities of dealing with a gas emergency.
- Demonstrate the safe working practices and procedures when dealing with gas escapes and other emergencies.
- State the procedure for surveying the site.
- Demonstrate how to prioritise emergency actions when dealing with gas escapes and other emergencies.
- Demonstrate how to undertake repairs to the network and make the site safe.
- State the final site safety check process.

### How much does it cost?

These courses are fully funded for independent learners. (Those not taking the course through and employee.)

Employees using Bootcamps to upskill their workforce will be required to pay a contribution. (10% for SME and 30% for larger employers)

### Am I eligible?

To be eligible you must be:

- Over 19 or older on 31<sup>st</sup> August within the current academic year
- Live within Gateshead, Sunderland, South Tyneside, Newcastle, North Tyneside, Northumberland or County Durham.
- Have the right to work in the UK.
