

NRSWA Supervisor Units LA and S1 to S7

This course equips engineers with the skills and knowledge required to supervise and monitor NRSWA operative activities in line with UK legislation. It focuses on maintaining safety standards and ensuring the continued integrity of highways. The training and assessment provided will enable those to achieve City & Guilds certification and registration on SWQR

- Demonstrate the location and avoidance of underground equipment (Unit LA)
- Monitoring of signing, lighting and guarding of works including traffic lights (Unit S1)
- Monitoring the correct techniques for excavation in the highway (Unit S2)
- Monitoring the correct techniques for the reinstatement and compaction of backfill materials (Unit S3)
- Monitoring the correct techniques for the reinstatement of sub-base and road base in non-bituminous materials (Unit S4)
- Monitoring the correct techniques for the laying and compaction of cold-lay bituminous materials (Unit S5)
- Monitoring the correct techniques for the reinstatement of concrete slabs (Unit S6)
- Monitoring the correct techniques for the reinstatement of modular surfaces and concrete footpaths (Unit S7)
