This gas safety assessment is designed to test the gas safety competence of an operative installation & commission of domestic gas meters only which are then sealed off at the meter outlet. The certificate is renewable every 5 years.

Completion of this qualification will enable individuals to show competency on the Gas Safe register.

- Re-establish gas supply & ensure gas tight.
- Correctly purge, working pressure checked.
